

Integrated Course Data Management- a Strategic Approach

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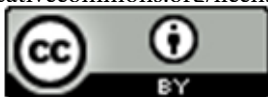
The introduction of a new program and course management system presented the University of South Australia an opportunity to not only offer a superior system for providing a course catalog and approval process, but also to use the entered course and assessment data in all downstream systems.

This presentation will focus on the course aspects of the newly built systems and associated business processes that:

- streamline the creation of a course statement and associated assessments
- allow the simple creation of a course outline document which includes the assessment data and associated due dates for each assessment
- automatically populates the assessment information in Moodle, including assessment title, weighting and due date
- propagate assessment marks through to the University PeopleSoft student system for final course grades for students.

The presentation will delve into three distinct systems, demonstrating the process flow and business benefits of the three systems to produce a seamless progression of the life cycle of a course.

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
